



Bikepark Leogang – general information (www.bikeparkleogang.com)

Since its opening in 2001, the Bikepark Leogang has established itself as one of the best recommended bike parks in Europe. The Bikepark Leogang is one of eleven carefully selected “Kona Groove Approved” bike parks worldwide

Leogang – the bike paradise for everyone!

This bike park provides an excellent range of activities for all bikers, for young and old, beginners, experts and pros. The park is not only for those riders who want to try out plenty of mountain bike DH trails, freeride stunts, Northshore ladders and bridges or dirt jumps. People who just want to ride some easy going freeride tours will have a lot of fun, too. The eight-person cable car takes bikers to the start of the park where various downhill routes lead into the valley

Trails & Service:

The **Speedster** (Downhill): Pure fun on a 2,300 meters long and technically very challenging trail. Gnarly roots, steep terrain (average Gradient: 20.7%) and jumps make the speedster a perfect thrill for advanced riders.

The **Flying Gangster** (Freeride): 2.5 km of pure adrenalin! Experience a fantastic flow on Bikepark Leogang’s freeride trail. It doesn’t matter, if you are a seasoned biker or an absolute beginner: the gravel trails, packed with numerous step ups and step downs, sharp curves, northshore ladders and tunnels, promise the ultimate freeride feeling. Beginners have the option to by-pass the various difficult passages.

NEW for 2009: A second freeride trail, the **Bongo Bongo**, diverts from the Flying Gangster about half way down. The Bongo Bongo is spiced up with a lot of northshore and solid rock sections, as well as berms and wallrides. A trail made for experienced riders looking for flow.

The **Hangman** (Single Trail): can be divided in two main sections:

A) From the mountain station to the middle station – technically very challenging, including tricky parts on small single trails and northshore elements. A mad experience!

B) From the eastside of the middle station to the valley station: This is a nice and easy going trail where you can test your skills before you try the freeride or downhill tracks. The best trail for beginners or to get the feeling for a rented bike.



The **Terminator** (Dual Slalom): Two riders can fight head to head, or simply enjoy this fast, smooth trail. Ideal for beginners, who wish to practice their jumps and curve techniques. You can also take advantage of the course's official timer, which is permanently installed and allows riders to measure their progress.

The **Flow Master** (Dirt Jump): Nine big sized jumps and two huge turns with berms for experienced riders and professionals. Official course of the 26TRIX – world biggest international mountain bike dirt jump contest. Guarantees the ultimate adrenalin buzz. The track is about 220 meters long and also features three additional, smaller sized doubles parallel to the last section of the track.

The **Lumberjack Trail** (Northshore): This northshore training park is located between the Terminator and the Flow Master. It features all kind of northshore elements: Drops (a half to over five meters height!), ladders and logs (width: 80 to 15 centimeters), bridges and Wallrides. Great to train your sense of balance, or to get the ultimate kick dropping.

The **4Cross** track at the end of the freeride trail requires all the skills you can muster. Up to four bikers can challenge each other over this course, heading full speed over tables, doubles and steep turns. It also features a permanent starting gate.

The **Mini Kids BikePark**: Practice tracks for children between 4 and 12 years, located right next to the valley station. Two different courses: One packed with small berms and tiny jumps, as well as a rather flat one with a very slight slope. Due to the Mini Kids BikePark, very young beginners have the chance to check out their abilities in mountain biking without any danger. A conveyor belt brings them up the start of both courses again.

The **Bikepark-Shop** is located right next to the valley station and offers a broad range of products: Bikes, components, clothing and gear. The Kona bikes rental features all kind of mountain bikes: Full suspension bikes, hardtails and juvenile bikes. A service and repairs shop helps you to get your bike ready for the sessions in the bike park.

Guided Tours and Training: discover the beautiful mountainscapes around Leogang with the help of local guides. You can also train your riding skills by getting instructions from professional mountain bike experts. There are separate training courses for beginners, advanced riders, as well as freeride trainings – all including video based analysis.



Events 2009:

May 21st to 24th (Thursday - Sunday):

Opening Weekend: take a look at the Brand new 2009 Kona renal bikes, fresh gear in the Bikepark-Shop, or have fun riding the new freeride track.

Bike-School Leogang – camps and tours:

Riding skills camps (for cross country bikers):

Improve your personal riding skills during two days with the help of a professional trainer and guide. **Dates:** May 21st and 22nd (registration until May 7th possible) and August 15th and 16th (registration until August 1st possible). **Fee:** 110 Euros per person for two days.

Riding skills camps "GIRLS ONLY":

Two days for girls only. Train your skills under guidance of a female and well-experienced trainer. **Dates:** May 23rd and 24th (registration until May 9th possible) and September 5th and 6th (registration until August 23rd possible). **Fee:** 110 Euros per person, for two days.

BIKE & HIKE - TOURS:

Brand new for 2009: Join this unique combination of mountain biking and hiking. Available all times on request.

TRANS PINZGAU – five days tour:

Go Trans Pinzgau – five days, 270 kilometers of single trails and 8.800 meters altitude difference. **Date:** July 1st till 5th (registration until June 17th possible). **Fee:** 490 Euros including four nights accommodation, half-board and luggage transport.

FREERIDE-CAMP:

New Freeride Camp for juveniles featuring three sessions and lessons two hours each.

Dates: for 12 to 14 years old: June 3rd until 5th, each day 2 pm until 4 pm; for 15 to 17 years old: June 17th until 19th, 2 pm until 4 pm each day. **Fees:** 140 Euros for the three days camp and 50 Euros for one single day.

DIRT-BASIC-CAMP:

Also new for 2009: Improve your dirt jump skills by training two days two hours each day on the Leogang Dirt Jumps. **Date:** May 31st and June 1st, 2 pm until 4 pm. **Fee:** 120 Euros for two days.
